Introducing July's rider of the month........... Mr. Craig McCarley #240 G Get to know more about this rider and why he was selected in this Holeshot issue July of 2014. Craig started riding BMX in 1972 to 1977. He used to ride on a horse trails, four-wheel-drive roads and drainage holes in the Pacific Paliades Highlands and around Will Rogers ranch. Here you'll see Craig riding in this 1980 photo at Indian dunes on an RM 125. Oh and that's Johnny O'Mara in the background watching him on the international track. There at that track you could buy a beer for \$2 in a 16 ounce cup. Craig stopped riding in 1987 and restarted in 1997. He started up again riding Shane Trittlers I-5 Gorman track. At the Gorman track Craig met his long-term friend Chris King. King said you're pretty fast out there and said you might like to try the OTHG club. So, in the summer of 2003 the gang was at Gorman racing. Craig signed up and WON the 38 novice class on his first ride with the gang. He rode 38 novice for one year and got moved to the 38 intermediate class and it took him 10 months before he could even get a top three podium finish. He got older and moved to the 45 intermediates. It took another four months till he won a Moto in the 45 intermediate class. In 2007 Craig finished second in points and he was first in the national championship series in the 45 intermediate class.

In 2008 he was moved to the expert class where he suffered the effects of a crash at the Tulare national. 10 months off racing and then back into the 45 intermediates. Craig wanted to mention his best friend in over the Hill gang motocross is Chris King. When he's driving to the track you'll often hear him play the trio band Rush in his truck to get charged for the day of racing. When he gets to the track the two guys he seems to get the best advice in about motocross is longtime longevity trophy receiving member and a previous #1 plate holder Jeff Blix and expert motorcross teacher Tom Baker who at the time of this publication sits in the #1 spot in points with the OTHG South chapter club. When Craig's not at the track he likes to spend his time hanging with his mom. When Craig has time to practice he likes riding with Jeff Hamblin, John Lombardo, Jim Wentz, Kon Bour, Tom Baker and Chris King. His best reason to race is for the competition, the camaraderie, the physical workout and the mental challenge to keep your head in the game especially under adverse conditions. His best memory was when he was 38 novice in 2003. He had practiced a lot at the Glen Helen track and he thought he had that national race in the bag. However, on every lap it seemed 574G past him over and over and Craig came back to make another pass to regain the lead. When it was all over 574g made more passes for the lead and therefore Jim Wentz won the 2003 over the Hill gang national.
